

TOWN OF PINEVILLE, NC

URBAN ARCHERY SEASON

January 9, 2016 – February 13, 2016

The rules governing the Urban Archery program in the Town of Pineville, NC are as follows:

- 1. All rules, regulations, and laws of the NCWRC apply.**
- 2. All rules, regulations, and laws of the State of North Carolina and the Town of Pineville apply.**
- 3. Hunting is only permitted on private property with written permission from the property owner for each individual hunting on the property. Hunting is allowed only in the areas identified by the Town of Pineville's Urban Archery Program map.**
- 4. Hunters should register at Pineville Town Hall, located at 200 Dover St., Pineville, NC 28134 prior to hunting. Written permission from the property owner will be required.**
- 5. No hunting on town-owned or public property.**
- 6. Use archery equipment only as allowed by the NCWRC – bow & arrow and crossbows.**
- 7. No alcohol, illegal drugs, or use of profanity while hunting on properties.**
- 8. No marking of properties.**
- 9. No motorized vehicles, or all-terrain vehicles, of any kind allowed for use while hunting.**
- 10. Must remove any trash generated.**
- 11. Climbing stands and blinds only and the blinds must have safety orange visible from each side.**
- 12. Hunters must wear orange at all times, which should be visible on all four sides.**
- 13. Hunting allowed only on two consecutive acres or more.**
- 14. Hunting must take place at least 300 ft. from any dwelling, occupied structure, or public road.**
- 15. Be as discreet as possible when entering, leaving, and removing game from properties. Do not discard or leave behind any remains or body parts.**
