URBAN ARCHERY SEASON  
(archery only)

January 14, 2017 – February 18, 2017

The rules governing the Urban Archery program in the Town of Pineville, NC are as follows:

- 1) All rules, regulations and laws of the NCWRC apply.
- 2) All rules, regulations and laws of the state of North Carolina and the Town of Pineville apply.
- 3) Hunting is *only* permitted on private property with *written permission from the property owner for each individual hunting on the property and only* in the areas indicated on the official map.
- 4) Hunters must register to participate in the Urban Archery Program at Pineville Town Hall, located at 200 Dover St., Pineville, NC 28134 *prior* to hunting and must bring with them:
  - a) Valid and current deer hunting license
  - b) Signed permission letter from the property owner to include: your name listed in the authorization statement allowing you to hunt, the date, the property owner's address where the hunting is taking place and property owner's signature
- 5) No hunting on town/public property.
- 6) Use archery equipment only as allowed by the NCWRC – bow & arrow and crossbows.
- 7) No alcohol, illegal drugs or use of profanity while hunting on properties.
- 8) No marking of properties, no motorized vehicle on properties.
- 9) Must remove any trash generated.
- 10) Climbing stands and blinds only and the blinds must have safety orange visible from each side.
- 11) Hunters must wear orange which should be visible on all four sides.
- 12) Hunting allowed only on two consecutive acres or more and only in the sections as highlighted in the official Urban Archery map.
- 13) Must be 250 ft. from any dwelling or occupied structure.
- 14) Be as discreet as possible when entering, leaving and removing game from properties. Do not discard or leave behind any remains or body parts.
