Jack D. Hughes Park was opened in the early 60's and the park was in need of a facelift, so in 2000 Pineville decided it was time for major renovations. Upon completion of Phase II, the park now has one multipurpose field for soccer/lacrosse/football, two softball fields, three picnic shelters, a playground and 1.5 mile walking trail. The showcase area of the park features a collegiate-size baseball field, offering grandstand seating for 250, a press box and concessions, making Pineville home to one of the nicest ball parks in the area. Jack D. Hughes Park has something for everyone!

The park hosts a multitude of tournaments year round, and serves as the home field for Charlotte Catholic's baseball and softball teams. CABL baseball, Nations Baseball, USSSA Baseball, ASA and NSA softball as well as adult league play, are sure to fill the grandstands with thousands of visitors to the community each year.
