## **The Manager's Minute**

As 2021 comes to a close there were a lot of changes that happened in Pineville. There were new residential and commercial developments, residential developments finishing, staff retirements and hirings, and new Council Members being elected.

The new Town Hall and Library was begun in 2021 and is slated to be completed in the summer of 2022. This will consolidate several operations for the town as well as provide state of the art services for town residents. The library will open up in the Fall of 2022. This new building will be

able to provide a lot of programming for children and citizens both inside the building and outside. We hope that it will be a meeting place for citizens to interact.

This year we also saw the election of two new Council members who ran unopposed, Ed Samaha and Chris McDonough. You may remember Councilor McDonough's name as he served on Council in the past. Councilor Samaha is new to our Council, but has past experience in the northeast. They will both be great additions to Town Council and will provide diverse views and experiences that will help the town in to the future. With the addition of these two members, the town lost two Council members. They were Councilor Davis and Councilor Maxim. They both served the town well and made tremendous contributions in their knowledge, skills, and love for the town. Please help me welcome Ed and Chris and wish Melissa and Joe well in their future endeavors. This position takes a lot of time, commitment, and love for the town.

Finally, Pineville's downtown is looking amazing with the storefronts being occupied and busy. Let's keep the momentum moving in to 2022 and truly make Pineville a destination community where people want to live, work, shop and play. We all need to work together to make Pineville the #1 destination community in the region for families.

In December, we said good-bye to two Council Members. Melissa Davis served two four-year terms and Joe Maxim served four years. Both were presented with proclamations and gifts of





The Reynolda House Museum of American Art displays a premiere collection of American art ranging from the colonial period to the present. Built in 1917 by Katharine Smith Reynolds and her husband R. J. Reynolds, founder of the R. J. Reynolds Tobacco Company, the house originally occupied the center of a 1,067-acre estate. It opened to the public as an institution dedicated to the arts and education in 1965, and as an art museum in 1967. The house holds one of the

country's finest collections of American paintings. It is located in Winston-Salem, North Carolina.
