



CRVA BOARD VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

The City of Charlotte has requested the appropriate representatives of the six Mecklenburg County towns jointly appoint a representative to the Board of Directors of the CRVA. The representative will be confirmed by the Charlotte City Council.

Under legislation establishing the CRVA, the North Carolina General Assembly stipulated that one member of the 13-member Board of Directors must be nominated by the six towns, acting together. The requirement is outlined in North Carolina session laws 2004-14 (HB 1564).

The initial appointment term is three years, with the possibility of extension by the City Council for a second three-year term. It has been customary for the representatives to alternate between a resident of the three northern towns and a resident of the three southern towns. If this practice continues, the next representative would be from Matthews, Mint Hill, or Pineville.

The appointment is currently scheduled to be confirmed by the City Council on August 28, 2023, provided there is a nomination from the Towns.
