### **New Business**

### **Approval of minutes:**

i. Yvette Isaacs made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting. Motion approved and seconded by Caylene Brown, ayes by all.

### **Director Updates:**

- i. Dog Park: Ryan Spitzer, town manager, has started quarterly town hall meetings. One thing that came out of the last meeting was having a small dog park area for small dogs. We are going to split the two openings and the small dog area will go down to the right side. The limit could be dogs 20 pounds and under. This will be put in our capital budget for the next fiscal year and hopefully happen by the summer.
- ii. LWCF Land Acquisition: Kristy Detwiler, former PR Director, was granted the 175K LWCF grant a few years ago for the land next to the dog park. The land has come back up for purchase. The Town of Pineville is very interested in purchasing this land since we have the matching grant for it. We could use it for disc golf, hiking trails, biking trails. It would be close to the greenway for easy access. Matt will email the LWCF plan to the board.
- Fall Fest: was at Jack Hughes in 2022. It went back before council at their last work session. Fall Fest
  will stay at Jack Hughes and add Thursday night as well for a 3-day festival. We will offer wristbands
  on Thursday night. We are meeting with police to figure out better ways for parking and traffic.
- iv. Pickleball: Outdoor Courts will be built with ARPA funds, \$486K that must be spent by 2026. We are looking to add outdoor pickleball courts. We are looking to add 4 courts to the flat area by the large shelter at Lake Park. We will get multiple quotes and go from there.
- v. Fitness Court: Has been moved to a different location. It is going to be in the grassy area to the left when you drive in at the Belle Johnston Community Center. Hopefully we will have this finished by June. Matt will send the board renderings of the fitness court.

- vi. Splashpad: We have added three new shade structures. We are getting rid of the grass inside the fence and concreting it in. We are looking to get a wrap around bench along the fence to provide more seating. Weather issues have delayed the concrete being put in.
- vii. Electrical Boxes: We are looking to paint the electrical boxes/transformers around downtown
  Pineville, Jack Hughes, and Lake Park. Matt contacted Queens University art department and their college students will be painting the boxes. They must show us mockups before they paint.

### **PPRAB Vacancies and Appointments:**

- i. James Dinkler has joined the PPRAB. He just moved to Pineville in March and grew up playing hockey at the Pineville Icehouse.
- ii. The PPRAB currently has 8 of 9 positions filled engage with neighbors and community members.

# **December/Holiday Programming**

- i. General feedback from board and community members:
  - a. Tree lighting: we didn't get to do the snow because it was too warm. 911 Dispatch had trouble hearing their calls with the music playing outside their building. They will try to soundproof the 911 dispatch room so they can hear emergency calls next year.
  - b. Caylene said the hot chocolate and smores ran out quickly. We had some issues with one of the water containers.
  - c. Parents were nervous about the lawn being so close to 51. When Santa pulled up the kids ran towards the road. Public Works has barricades that we could put up to help protect from the road next year.
