What's Happening...



The Town has many projects in the works this year. These investments give shape to the necessary plans, policies and programs outlined in the Pineville Comprehensive Plan.

Phase 1 of the Johnston Road project is underway, and the expected completion date is this summer. The road work is behind schedule due to obtaining the needed easements for the temporary placement of the traffic signal. They will be starting on the water line within the next week and anticipate Phase 1 completion by early summer. Once this is complete, we are hoping to have the same company to bid on Phase 2 and keep it going. There will be additional downtown parking once this project is complete.

The Greenway to McCullough will be completed by Fall 2024. The future bicycle system will allow bicyclists a safe method of travel and encourage active transportation. This greenway will aid in pedestrian connectivity, as well.

In the future, all major roads in Pineville will have connected sidewalks or multi-use paths. In combination with crossings, sidewalks connect community members to their homes, places of work, and recreation and shopping areas. We are currently taking bids to contract new sidewalks adjacent to the Sabel Point apartments by the end of summer. Bids open in April with construction thereafter.

The Town Hall fountain work will begin the first part of April and be completed by the end of June as part of the loan obtained for Town Hall. This will create a mini park and provide a great natural amenity for all. The Pineville Comprehensive Plan establishes a vision based on community input, and rooted in an understanding of what makes the Town an attractive place to live, work, invest and visit.

The Town's Social District will be opening within two months to coincide with the warming weather. Spring is a perfect time to stroll through Downtown to visit our amazing businesses and see the hard work and investments made by local entrepreneurs. I hope everyone also takes the opportunity as Spring comes around and the weather improves, to visit our amazing parks and take advantage of the programs and events the Town puts on.

Public Service



JUNK WEEK MAY 13-17, 2024

Our Public Works Department will ride through town to pick up any old unwanted items. This is not a service offered by our trash collection company; this is a service offered **FREE OF CHARGE** from the Town

to its residents. Please take advantage of this once-a-year opportunity to get your junk removed. In order to keep this great opportunity going year after year, we ask that you kindly follow a few simple rules that have been put in place:

- Minor renovation, flooring and other construction debris is acceptable ONLY if it is a reasonable amount, metal or work posts, or planks do not exceed four feet in length, and all nails or other hazardous items removed or nailed down safely for pickup without injury.
- Absolutely no excrement, bodily fluids or other biohazardous material of any kind will be picked up.
- We can no longer pick up paint or petroleum products of any kind.
- Items must be taken to the curb for pickup; employees are not permitted to go into your house to remove items or move them for you. Additionally, we do not want to take Town trucks into our alleyways, so please take your items to the front of the house to be picked up safely and easily.
- Separate glass or other breakable items from any wood, metal, plastic or other products you put out at the curb.
- Town employees have the right to refuse pickup of items they deem unsafe or hazardous.

One final sweep of the Town will be made the following week to collect whatever was not collected during the week of pickup. As long as these rules are followed and common safety sense is used, this program will continue to run. We appreciate your cooperation.



TRAFFIC RADAR SIGNS

While driving you may have noticed our newly installed Radar signs located at Jack Hughes Lane and the intersection of Main Street and Polk Street. These two radar signs are a helpful indicator of the **speed**

limit on Main Street (20 MPH). Our two primary goals of traffic enforcement within the town are reducing the number of fatal collisions and changing driver behavior. These two signs help us accomplish this goal by giving drivers a very visible warning of their speed and the speed limit itself to get drivers to slow down. By getting vehicles to slow down there is a measurable reduction in vehicle collisions, especially collisions involving injuries. These signs also collect data that is used to create targeted enforcement events in an effort to keep our downtown corridor safe. These signs are also a reminder to those who pass through Pineville that they should heed the speed limit as it is strictly enforced.

KEEP THE WATER CLEAR

Did you know that sediment (or mud/dirt) is the number one stormwater pollutant in our County? Sediment makes



its way into our creeks and lakes by flowing with stormwater into storm drains which lead directly to waterways, such as Little Sugar Creek. Once it enters the waterways it can destroy habitat for aquatic life, such as fish and tadpoles, by removing dissolved

oxygen and degrading conditions needed to sustain life. Sediment can come from construction sites or any other area where dirt is exposed. Silt fences should be set up around the perimeter of construction sites to help keep sediment on-site. Planting grasses or vegetation can help stabilize any exposed dirt on your property. If you see sediment run-off flowing to a storm drain or a creek that looks impacted, call 311 and Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services will come investigate. Help us keep our waterways clean for all to enjoy.




