Town of Pineville Recognizes Senate Passage of the P.A.V.E. Act as a Win for Regional Transportation

PINEVILLE, N.C. – The Town of Pineville celebrates the North Carolina Senate's second reading passage of HB 948, known as the P.A.V.E. Act. This legislation marks a significant step forward in addressing the growing transportation and mobility needs of Mecklenburg County—benefiting towns like Pineville that are experiencing rapid growth and increased infrastructure demands.

With Pineville's strategic location on the edge of the county, strong transportation solutions are critical to connecting residents, businesses, and visitors throughout the region. The bipartisan effort behind the P.A.V.E. Act is being recognized as a major win for towns and cities alike.

The Charlotte Executive Leadership Council also noted the significance of the bill's passage, reflecting the unity between government, business, and community interests.

The P.A.V.E. Act is scheduled for a third and final reading in the Senate tomorrow. Once passed, the bill will return to the House for a concurrence vote before heading to the governor's desk for final approval.
